From the desk of Dereck...

HOW HAS COVID IMPACTED YOUR WORLD, WE ARE STEWARDS NOT OWNERS

"Command those who are rich in this present age not to be haughty, nor to trust in uncertain riches but in the living God, who gives us richly all things to enjoy." -1 Timothy 6:17

Most of us would not think of ourselves as rich compared to the world's wealthiest people. Yet even folk on the lowest rung of the economic ladder still are wealthy in comparison to the standard of living in most of the world today.

Today, if you have a roof over your head, a bed to sleep in, and some form of transportation, then compared to many people around the world, you are rich. Of course, you can enjoy what God has blessed you with. That is not a sin living in the blessed life God has enabled you to live.

However, the apostle Paul wrote to Timothy, "Command those who are rich in this present age not to be haughty, nor to trust in uncertain riches but in the living God, who gives us richly all things to enjoy" (1 Timothy 6:17 NKJV).

We are not owners, but stewards, of what God has entrusted into our possession. Along these lines, Paul told the believers in Philippi that their financial gift to him would result in a reward for them: "Not that I seek the gift, but I seek the fruit that abounds to your account" (Philippians 4:17 NKJV).

Paul was saying, "When you give to me or to the ministry I'm involved in, it will result in fruit to your account. God will credit you for that." So often we want to hoard the credit and assume that when we do something wonderful it's because of ourselves and we struggle to see that many other folk have enabled us to do the work. It's a combined effort and communal accolade.

There is an incredible thing for us to think about. Many folks who have passed on from Covid or its comorbidities, have left behind whatever they had on this earth, all the things will be divided among their relatives or whomever they have chosen to inherit. There are and there will be many fights about who wants what and who wants more, but truth be told they will also leave behind everything they clamoured for.

On the other hand, whatever you have invested in the work of God's kingdom—every Rand you gave for ministry, every cent you contributed for the preaching of the gospel or for the support of your church—will result in spiritual fruit to your account. No one can take it away from you as you gave to God for His purposes.

So do not put your hope in wealth. Instead, use what God has given you for good. Invest in His Kingdom for eternal value and reward in this life and the life to come.
